

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING** **OLD TOWN SPRING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT**



The District will consider and act upon the following matters:

7. To receive the Investment Officer's Report.
8. To receive and discuss the Visitors Bureau Report and take any action.
9. To receive and discuss the Longhorn Rod Run.
10. To review and discuss existing Preservation Park Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and the needs of Old Town Spring.
11. To review, discuss and approve repairs and purchases required by the District's facilities, buildings, and equipment.
12. To review, discuss and take action on beautification projects within the District.
13. To review, discuss and take action on lampposts, including repairs.
14. To receive a report from the County Commissioner's Office.
15. To review, discuss and take action on 2024 District Investment Policy.
16. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.072 to deliberate regarding real estate matters.
17. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel regarding pending or contemplated litigation, settlement offers or on matters which require confidentiality under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas.
18. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.074 to discuss personnel matters.
19. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.089 to deliberate regarding security assessments or deployments relating to information resources technology, network security information, or the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel, critical infrastructure, or security devices.

20. To review, discuss and take action on District personnel matters including compensation, retention, and hiring or termination of District employees.
21. To review and act on real estate matters, including but not limited to purchase, sale, lease, utilities, encumbrances, easements and other matters related to real property transactions.
