
The District will consider and act upon the following matters:

11. To review, discuss and take action on lampposts, including repairs.

13. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.072 to deliberate regarding real estate matters.
14. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel regarding pending or contemplated litigation, settlement offers or on matters which require confidentiality under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas.
15. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.074 to discuss personnel matters.
16. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.089 to deliberate regarding security assessments or deployments relating to information resources technology, network security information, or the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel, critical infrastructure, or security devices.
17. To review, discuss and take action on District personnel matters including compensation, retention, and hiring or termination of District employees.
18. To review and act on real estate matters, including but not limited to purchase, sale, lease, utilities, encumbrances, easements and other matters related to real property transactions.
